The internship was carried out according to the Learning Agreement for CDL "Applied electronic circuits", structured on three large activities: "Special characteristics of the workplace", "Electronic circuits, characteristics" and "Design and realization of electronic circuits".

- The 15 students selected from Grades X B and X C completed 90 hours of practice in Paphos, Cyprus at P. Kousios Electrical Ltd
- The students went through several evaluation stages at the internship site: initial, intermediate (after 7 days) and final; they filled in the practice notebooks daily, they filled in the personal impression sheets daily and completed the three questionnaires (one initial before departure, one intermediate, for feedback after // days and one for the final feedback).

- The intermediary partner from Cyprus, Rivensco Consulting LTD, through its manager Michalis Papatherapontos, assured the participants:
- transfer from Larnaca Airport to Paphos and return
- accommodation and meals at Hotel Kissos, in Paphos (internet access, outdoor pool, indoor pool, conference room, table tennis, etc.)
- transport tickets on local buses for the movement of participants to and from the practice site or for walks in the city
- the 10-hour Greek language course
- tours in Limassol, in Nicosia
- access to touristic & cultural sights in Paphos and surroundings

Students in stream 1- Cyprus participated in a number of very attractive and impressive cultural and recreational activities:

Excursion to Limassol and stops at the Rocks of Aphrodite, the Temple of Apollo and the vast archaeological site near Limassol

Excursion to Nicosia (visiting the old town in the Cypriot area then the bazaar in the Turkish area of the capital)

Visiting the Fort of Paphos, located in the port

Visiting the archaeological site of Paphos with the famous mosaics

Visit to the "Tombs of the Kings"-Paphos

Mediterranean sand beach in Paphos and Coral Bay

Musical evenings organized in the hotel.

Results

The 15 students were appreciated with maximum marks in the practical classes and also successfully completed the Greek language course.

At the end of the mobility period, the students received:

Europass Mobility certificates

Certificates certifying participation in all project activities, including the Greek language course.

The score received by the students following the evaluation of the internship was equated and validated in the form of grades that are entered in the class catalogs at the corresponding CDL.

Host organization - Ferreirolux-Comércio e Industria de Material Eléctrico, Lda, Barcelos, Portugal

Practice tutor – Susana Ferreira

The internship took place according to the Learning Agreement for CDL "Electrical equipment-practical applications", structured on three large activities: "Special characteristics of the workplace", "Electrical measurements" and "Practical applications, electrical circuits, assemblies".

- The 15 students selected from the 10th D and 10th A vocational school classes, electrical profile, carried out 90 hours of practice in Barcelos at Ferreirolux-Comércio e Industria de Material Eléctrico, Lda.
- The students went through several evaluation stages at the internship site: initial, intermediate (after 7 days) and final; they filled in the practice notebooks daily, they filled in the personal impression sheets daily and completed the three questionnaires (one initial before departure, one intermediate, for feedback after 7 days and one for the final feedback) and received appreciations maximum.

The intermediate partner from Barcelos, Associação Intercultural Amigos da Mobilidade, through its manager Nuno Varajão Barbosa, assured the participants:

- -accommodation and meals in the Mobility Friends campus; the campus offered students facilities such as: internet, swimming pool, football field, volleyball field, mini-golf field, billiard room, fitness devices, conference room, canteen, barbecue area, disco room, etc.
- the transfer from the Madrid Airport to the campus upon arrival and from the campus to Porto upon departure;
- transport from the campus to and from the place of practice
- 4 excursions, with a guide
- 10 hours of Portuguese language, with Prof. Joana Patrão.

The following were organized for stream 2 students:

- -a guided trip to Valença and Viana do Castello (au reached the shore of the Atlantic Ocean)
- a guided trip to Braga and Guimaraes
- a guided tour of Porto
- a trip to Barcelos,

they visited impressive cathedrals, castles and sanctuaries everywhere, admired the architecture of the buildings and cobbled streets in the old parts of the cities visited, bought souvenirs in the Barcelos market and took part in a cruise on the Douro River in Porto.

Results

At the end of the mobility period, Mobility Friends organized a celebration for the participants to award the related certificates; students received:

- **Europass Mobility certificates**
- Certificates of participation in all project activities
- Certificate certifying the passing of the Portuguese language course
- Personalized t-shirts with the association emblem, folders, pens, souvenirs in the form of the local symbol the Rooster from Barcelos
- On the last Friday night, a "Black and White" party was organized for the students and a social evening for the accompanying teachers.

- Signing contracts with external partners
- Monitoring of student activity, etc.


